


REGULATIONS

Revised 03.16.2017

- I. The GFA Cup will follow the **CURRENT edition of the FIFA Laws** with the modifications made below.
- II. Law 2 – The Ball: All matches must use the official match ball provided by the GFA Women’s Committee. Other match balls may be used only if, at the discretion of the referee, the match balls are deemed unworthy for use.
- III. Law 3 – The Number of Players (Substitutions): Teams have unlimited substitution opportunities during a match and may substitute an unlimited number of players per dead ball. Substitutes must enter the field at the half line after player has left the field, and only with the permission of the referee. Players may re- enter the match after being substituted.
- IV. Law 4 – The Players Equipment
 - a. Uniforms
 - i. With the exception of the goalkeeper, all players on a team must wear similar color jerseys, same color shorts and same color socks. A variation in color shades for shorts and socks is acceptable.
 - ii. The goalkeeper must wear a jersey of a different color than that of her teammates and that of her opponents.
 - iii. All players must wear a unique jersey number listed on the official roster. Numbers may not be taped to the jersey.
 - iv. A field player substituting a goalkeeper must wear a number different than the goal keeper she is replacing. It may be a different number than hers field player jersey as long as no other player on the roster has the same number.
 - v. A goalkeeper substituting a field player must wear a number different than the field player she is replacing. It may be a different number than her goalkeeper jersey as long as no other player on the roster has the same number.
 - vi. If, in the opinion of the referee, there is a uniform conflict, the home team must use a different colored jersey. Mesh-style vests/bibs/pennies of the same color may be used as an alternative.
 - b. Jewelry and Casts/Splints
 - i. With the exception of a Medical Alert necklace/bracelet, players may not wear jewelry of any kind. This includes watches, fashion bracelets, rubber bands, necklaces, etc.
 - ii. Players may not participate in a match if they are wearing a hard, unyielding cast or splint – even if padded.
- V. Law 12: Fouls and Misconduct
 - a. Ejection - Managers, coaches or any non-players in the technical area who, at the discretion of the referee, are guilty of committing a sending-off offence will be asked to leave the field of play (ejected).
 - b. Players sent-off and non-players ejected must leave immediately and remain at least 30 yards away from the field of play.

Additional Tournament Rules:

VI. Player Eligibility

- a. Players must be eligible to play in their High School Soccer Team.
- b. All players must submit a waiver of liability or a current (orange colored) GFA player card.**

VII. Grace period

- a. There is no grace period. A match may not commence unless both teams can produce no less than 7 players by the scheduled kickoff time. Any team that fails to meet theirs will forfeit the match

VI. Roster

- a. Roster limit: unlimited
- b. Rosters with player waiver forms or a current GFA p layer card must be submitted to the **TEAM WELCOME TABLE** between 3:30 and 5:00 on the day of the tournament and should have the following information: full name, jersey number, year of birth
- c. Starters for the match must be Indicated with an asterisk.

VII. Format

- a. The format of the Girls High School Challenge Cup will be modified DOUBLE Elimination , i.e. teams that lose during the first round of play are eligible for the consolation Silver Cup .
- b. 1 – 30 minute match, NO half time (2) referees for the match. 3 man system for Gold Championship Match which will ALSO be ONE 30 minute match, no half time
- c. Matches in the CONSOLATION bracket will be 25 minutes, no half time

VIII. Extra Time & Penalties

WINNERS BRACKET

- a. In the event that the scores are level after normal time, kicks from the penalty mark will be taken in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game
- b. If the scores are still level after each team has taken 5 kicks, sudden death will decide the winner.

CONSOLATION BRACKET

- a. in the event that the scores are level after normal time, SUDDEN DEATH kicks from the penalty mark will be taken in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game**

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF GFA PLAYING PITCH

- CLEATS ONLY ON TURF. OTHER TYPES OF FOOTWEAR, INCLUDING BARE FEET, ARE **NOT** ALLOWED AT ANY TIME ON TURF. PLEASE USE SIDEWALKS IF PROPER FOOTWEAR IS NOT WORN.
- COOLERS ON TURF ARE **NOT** ALLOWED AT ANY TIME. PLEASE USE SIDEWALKS WHEN BRINGING COOLERS WITH WHEELS TO RESPECTIVE BENCHES.
- SPECTATORS **NOT** ALLOWED INSIDE FENCE AT ANY TIME.
- EXCEPTION: EMERGENCY/FIRST AID RESPONDERS DURING TREATMENTS
