- Triple J Auto Group officially joins Guam Football Association as a corporate partner


FEBRUARY


MARCH

- The Honorable Eddie Calvo, Governor of Guam, Attorney General Leonardo Rapadas, Director of Parks & Recreation Ray Blas, Agat Mayor Carol Tayama, and Santa Rita Mayor Dale Alvarez officially sign an MOU for the construction and maintenance of a southern soccer facility during a press conference attended by local dignitaries, GFA corporate partners, and representatives from Guam's soccer clubs.
- Triple J Auto Group held a press conference at the Triple J Auto Group showroom to offficially announce its partnership with Guam Football Association for two years.
- The Matao, Guam men's national football team, plays in its firstever cross-continental friendly matches against Aruba

The Matao introduced its new 2014 game kits in Aruba, the same game kits used in two international tournaments later in the year.

Guam led 2-1 against Aruba in the teams' first meeting up until the final minute, but a penalty kick awarded to Aruba in the final seconds forced a 2-2 draw with the host country. The host country later defeated Guam 2-0 in the second contest.

APRIL

Guam Football Association held its 2014 Congress at the Fiesta Resort Guam

The Guam FA Congress is held every two years, headlined by the elections for Executives and Executive Committee members. Each Executive and Executive Committee member hold their posts for four years, as elections are staggered for the ten positions. In 2014, three Executive Committee spots were available, with the Sidekick SC's Gian Tenorio and the Tigers' Kun Ho Rhee retaining their seats. New to the Executive Committee is Southern Heat's Tina Esteves.

In the U8 division, the Bulldogs repeated as champions, the Tigers Sharks won the U10 division, and the Wings Red won the U12 division

 Guam Football Association welcomed teams from the Philippines to compete in the 2014 Youth Games - Football

The Wings won the U14 division of the 2014 Youth Games with a 4-1 win over Forza FC from the Philippines. In the U12 division, Don Bosco youth football team from the Philippines defeated the Wings 8-1 in the division final.

The tournament also featured U16 Girls division friendly matches with the La Salle U16 women's team from the Philippines, Guam All-Stars, and the Mini Masakaåda, Guam U14 Girls national team split into two teams.

Tournament top scorer Paige Surber scored six goals and tournament MVP Samantha Kaufman scored five goals. Cassandra "Cici" Kobinski scored twice. Other goal scorers were Lauren Valla, Dani Zavala, Maria Amezola, Simie Willter, Inyssa Perez, and an own goal during the match against Macau.
